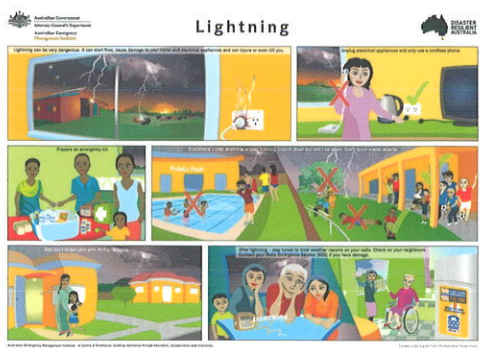
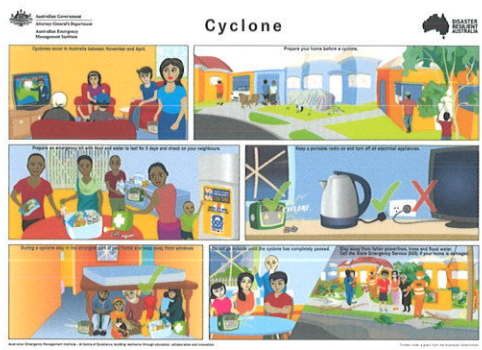

Pictorial action guides have been developed for culturally and linguistically diverse communities to help them understand the risks associated with natural hazards that may occur in Australia.

Each pictorial action guide depicts a different hazard – cyclone, earthquake, flood, heatwave, lightning and severe storm – and the relevant good and bad actions.

The guides aim to help individuals and communities understand what could happen and how best to be prepared to minimise any adverse effects.
