




# Capacity-building on Crisis Management and Assistance to Migrant Nationals: **The Philippines**

# BACKGROUND



Dozens of emergency situations involving Filipino migrants

- *Wars*
- *Epidemic outbreaks*
- *Terrorist attacks and hostage situations*
- *Industrial conflicts and labor disputes*
- *Piracy in the high seas*
- *Crackdown in irregular migrants*
- *Environmental disasters*
- *Political crises*

# IOM-RP PARTNERSHIP



DFA and DOLE confirmed the need to enhance the capacity of duty-bearers, including those posted in Assistance to Nationals Unit (ATNU) and the Philippine Overseas Labor Offices (POLO) among others, **to proactively anticipate or respond to the various crisis situations confronting migrants in a systematic and coordinated manner, in partnership with relevant organizations and stakeholders.**




# OBJECTIVE

- **National Conference on Crisis Management and Assistance to Migrant Nationals**
- Launch the IOM **Migration Crisis Operational Framework** (MCOF) in the Philippines.
- Workshops and consultations in the preparation of the **Operations Manual on Crisis Management and Assistance to Migrant Nationals**
- Develop **interactive training tool**

# PROPOSED ACTIVITIES



- Conduct of **classroom-level trainings**
  - Security **information analysis and dissemination**
  - **Prevention** of **sexual exploitation** and **abuse**
  - Prevention of **gender-based violence** affecting migrants caught in crises
  - **Case management** and **psycho-social support** for migrants in crisis situations
  - **Conflict resolution** (conciliation, mediation, negotiation, etc.)
  - **Post-assignment debriefing** programme for consular and diplomatic officials and staff returning from **hardship posts**
